
The LHOA

The Livingston Homeowners Association (LHOA) is a not-for-profit organisation, responsible for the operations and maintenance of community assets, such as; entry features, amenities, and The Hub. Additionally the LHOA delivers social, educational, and recreational programming, events, and activities for residents to enjoy.

The Hub is a 35,000 square foot recreational facility featuring a Banquet Hall, community kitchen, full size gymnasium and three additional rental spaces. The outdoor park features a splash park, 2 ice rinks, a firepit, and amphitheater.

Despite having over 3,500 households Livingston is still in its early stages, at only 30% build out. Once completed Livingston will have 11,000 households and around 45,000 residents.

Taste of Eid

April 5th

Our largest event of the year, drawing crowds of over 2,500 attendees. This event offers a sausage lunch, live music and entertainment, bouncy castles, face painting, and a petting zoo.

End of Summer Movie Night September 13th

Celebrate the end of the season with a relaxed and family-friendly evening under the stars. Guests can enjoy classic movie snacks like popcorn and drinks, along with fun pre-show games and activities for all ages. As the sun sets, everyone settles in for a special outdoor movie screening on the big screen. It's the perfect way to wrap up the summer with friends, family, and the community.

Diwali October 19th

Diwali lights up the skies of Livingston with a firework show.
